To ensure our club undertakes Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks for members of staff, helpers and/or volunteers when necessary and treats confidential disclosures appropriately by:

- Understanding the legal requirements for undertaking a DBS check
- Following the DBS check processes as required
- Having procedures in place for the collection, storage and disposal of confidential materials which meets the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- Ensuring that guidelines are kept up to date by regularly reviewing them.
