### About Us

At the heart of our work is The Bungalow Youth Project, a dedicated youth space where young people are welcomed as they are.

The Bungalow Youth Project is delivered by Buckfastleigh Community Development Project (Trust), a registered charity rooted in a simple belief: that young people already hold the strengths and potential to shape their own futures — and that our role is to create the conditions where that can happen.

Over time, our practice has evolved. We are not a service that “fixes” young people. We are a space that walks alongside them.

Our approach is trauma-informed, recognising that behaviour is communication and that many young people arrive carrying experiences that impact how they engage with the world. We prioritise safety, consistency and trust — creating an environment where young people can regulate, build relationships, and begin to see themselves differently.

We focus on:

- **Belonging before behaviour** — creating a space where young people feel safe, seen and accepted
- **Relationships first** — building trusted, consistent connections with adults and peers
- **Youth voice and agency** — young people shape what happens here, from activities to culture
- **Strength-based development** — recognising skills, potential and leadership, not deficits

Through this, we support young people to:

- Develop emotional resilience and self-awareness

- Build confidence, identity and a sense of purpose
- Form positive relationships with peers, family and the wider community
- Take ownership of their space and their role within it

Our work is dynamic and continually evolving. We listen, adapt and grow alongside the young people we serve — ensuring that The Bungalow remains a relevant, trusted and sustainable part of the community.

### **Purpose of the Job:**

To support the delivery of high-quality youth work that engages young people, builds relationships, and enables them to develop confidence, voice and a sense of belonging within their community.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Contribute to the planning and delivery of engaging youth programmes
- Build positive, consistent relationships with young people
- Support a safe, inclusive and welcoming environment
- Work collaboratively as part of a team, contributing ideas and feedback
- Reflect on practice and support continuous improvement
- Ensure food is consistently embedded within all sessions, recognising its role in wellbeing, relationship-building and creating a sense of belonging.
- Support the development and delivery of seasonal and holiday programmes, including school holiday and summer provision
- Support strong communication and teamwork across the project

### **Core Role: Youth Sessions**

You will play a key role in delivering youth sessions that are safe, engaging and led by young people's needs.

### **Responsibilities include:**

- Plan and prepare sessions in advance, with clear aims and outcomes
- Involve young people in planning, delivery and evaluation
- Deliver face-to-face youth work (evenings/weekends as required)
- Create engaging, fun and meaningful activities
- Work within agreed budgets
- Recognise and celebrate young people's achievements
- Plan for and provide food as part of each session, ensuring it is safely prepared, inclusive and accessible to all young people
- Support young people to purchase and prepare food within agreed session budgets
- Maintain accurate session records and registers
- Follow safeguarding and online safety procedures at all times
- Report concerns promptly to management

- Take and upload appropriate photos (in line with consent and policy)
- Participate in session debriefs and reflective practice
- Track and evidence young people’s development
- Maintain a clean, safe environment before and after sessions

**Core Role: Admin and Team Contribution**

- Contribute to programme planning and development
- Support youth voice across the organisation
- Follow all safeguarding, health & safety and organisational policies
- Reflect on sessions and identify improvements
- Contribute ideas for future activities and programmes
- Support planning and preparation for larger-scale programmes, including summer delivery and partnership-based activities
- Maintain organisation of resources and building standards

**General Responsibilities**

- Represent and promote The Bungalow Youth Project positively
- Maintain up-to-date knowledge of policies and procedures
- Work in line with trauma-informed and youth-led practice
- Maintain a safe, welcoming and inclusive environment
- Be flexible and responsive to the needs of the organisation and young people
